



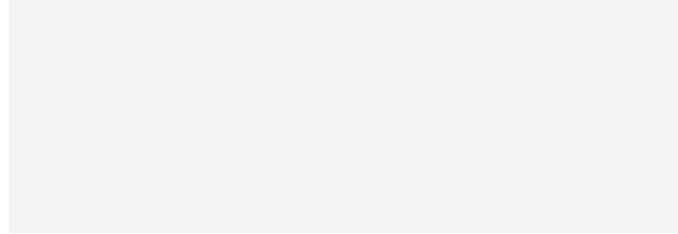

How To Get To Beachcomber

A. From the Garden State Parkway:

Take the Parkway South to Exit 4A (Route 47 North) to the third traffic light. Turn left onto Railroad Ave. (U.S. Post Office on corner.)

Beachcomber entrance is less than 1 mile on your right.

B. From Route 55 / Route 47:

Follow Route 55 South to the end & pick up Route 47 South. Follow 47/347/47 South to Rio Grande. Turn right onto Railroad Ave. (Just past U.S. Post Office at Rio Grande). Beachcomber entrance is less than 1 Mile on your right.

C. From Cape May/Lewes Ferry:

Follow Route 9 North to the 4th traffic light. Turn left onto Seashore Road. Entrance will be approx. 3 miles on the left.

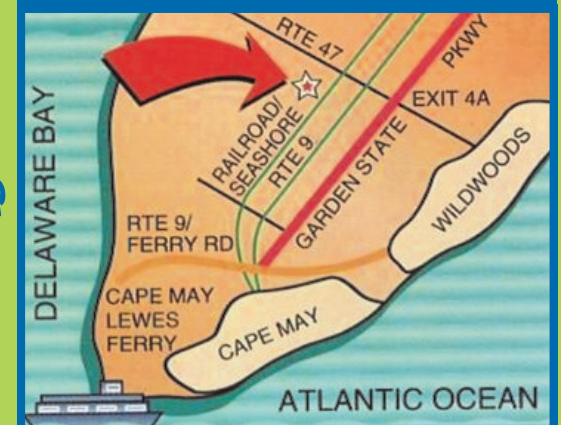
D. From Delaware & Maryland:

Take I-95 NE to I-295 (Delaware Memorial Bridge). Take Exit 2 to NJ Turnpike, then take Exit 1 to Route 40 E. Follow Route 40 to Route 55. Continue journey as stated in B.

E. From Philadelphia:

Take I-76 E. to Walt Whitman Bridge. Continue on Route 42 to the Atlantic City Expressway to exit 7S (Garden State Parkway S). Continue journey as stated in A.
